Since adopting the HOUSING FIRST model in 2006, Homeward Bound has moved 2,615 people into housing.

COMPASS POINT VILLAGE opened in September 2023 after converting a local motel into 85 permanent supportive housing units for Asheville's most vulnerable, chronically-homeless community members.





AHOPE WELCOMED 1,439 unhoused community members, providing thousands of showers, hot cups of coffee, and pairs of socks!



OUR WELCOME HOME DONATION CENTER transformed 176 housing units into homes by delivering \$204,605 of gently-used furnishings donated by you—our generous community!



OUR OUTREACH TEAM helped 265 people living outside on the streets, in cars, under bridges, and in tents—linking them to critically needed services, including:


- emergency shelters
